"Since its inception in 2012, GOGLA has created and funded many invaluable partnerships and influenced local policy across the world by advocating for favourable tax treatment of solar products, recognising their significant social and environmental impacts," he explained.

Commenting on the announcement, GOGLA Executive Director Koen Peters said, "As one of the co-founders of d.light, Ned is an experienced and highly respected figure in the off-grid energy sector. His insight is of huge value in our efforts at GOGLA to raise the profile of our sector and ensure that influential policy makers and funders understand the significant impact of affordable, renewable off-grid energy in improving people's everyday lives and driving social and economic development as well. With Ned's help, we intend to attract new capital, including grants, subsidies, debt, and equity into the sector as well as advocating for favourable government policies to the off-grid sector."

Tozun continued, "I look forward to working closely with my other board members and GOGLA's wider membership. We all share the common goal of extending access to safe, clean, reliable and affordable renewable energy to every household and community beyond the reach of existing grids and infrastructure. With our combined, coordinated efforts, we can achieve this shared goal."

New GOGLA Board members are nominated by existing members, with each term lasting for a period of three years. d.light was elected to the board in 2019 and re-elected in 2022. Tozun will replace outgoing d.light representative Charlotte Heffer who has left the company.
